PROVISIONAL EXAM RESULTS 2017

GCSE:

With 194 students in Year 11, students at Sir John Cass Red Coat School have performed exceptionally well again this year in their GCSE examinations.

Results Highlights:

- 24% of all GCSE entries were graded A*-A.
- 69% of students achieve a grade 5 or higher in GCSE English with 22% of students achieving a grade 9-7 (A*-A equivalent) in English.
- 7 students achieved a grade 9 in English Language.
- 48% achieved a grade 5 (strong pass) in English and Maths and at least 3 other GCSEs at A*-C.
- 70% of students achieved a grade 4 (standard pass) in English and Maths and at least 3 other GCSEs at A*-C.
- 95% of girls achieved grade 4+ in English and 89% achieved grade 5+ in English.
- 78% of boys achieved grade 4+ in English and 55% achieved grade 5+ in English.
- 85% of all girls achieved a grade 4 in maths and 61% achieved a grade 5+ in maths.
- 72% of all boys achieved a grade 4 in maths and 51% achieved a grade 5+ in maths.

There was exceptional performance across a range of subjects including:

- 49% of students achieved the Ebacc
- 80% of students achieved an A*-A in Chemistry
- 63% A*-A in Physics
- 57% A*-A in Biology
- 70% Distinction*-Distinction in Business
- 100% A*-C in Biology
- 100% A*-C in Chemistry
- 100% A*-C in Physics
- 82% A*-C/ 9-4 in English Literature
- 78% A*-C/ 9-4 in Maths
- 83% A*-C in History
- 68% A*-C in Core Science

Many students achieved A* to A and Level 8 and 9 grades. A few success stories to celebrate include:
