I would like to invite you to the KS4 Options evening at which you and your child can inquire further into the GCSEs and /or vocational courses they will follow for the next two years. By Friday 1st March your child will be given the KS4 Options booklet which describes the curriculum that your child will follow at Key Stage 4. Additionally, your child will be given their options form a week *before* the Options evening. **It is important that you bring the booklet to the Options evening on the 11th March along with the options form to record your child's option choices.**

You will also have the opportunity to speak to the school's Careers Manager, Mr Uddin as well as the Careers Adviser from Tower Hamlets Careers Service for independent and impartial advice on pathways to their chosen careers.
