RE: Stepney All Saints Uniform (Year 7)

Following the school name change and new school logo, we are now ready to start taking orders for the new school uniform.

We have a small stock of blazers in school, which we hope to distribute to year 7 students before the end of this term. However the PE kit and jumpers are on order and we anticipate that they will be available to collect in the new year.

Uniform List

All students must wear the full and correct uniform for school, school occasions and PE lessons. However given the current situation there will be some flexibility in the PE kit uniform items until we have the full uniform in stock. Ordering Uniform

Due to covid-19 we have reduced the number of visitors on-site, and therefore we ask that you use the size measuring guide at the end of this letter to establish the best size fit for your child when placing your order.

Once we have your uniform items in stock we will contact you to make payment via Parent Pay, selecting the correct items of uniform you have chosen to purchase www.parentpay.com.

Re-imbusement of Uniform

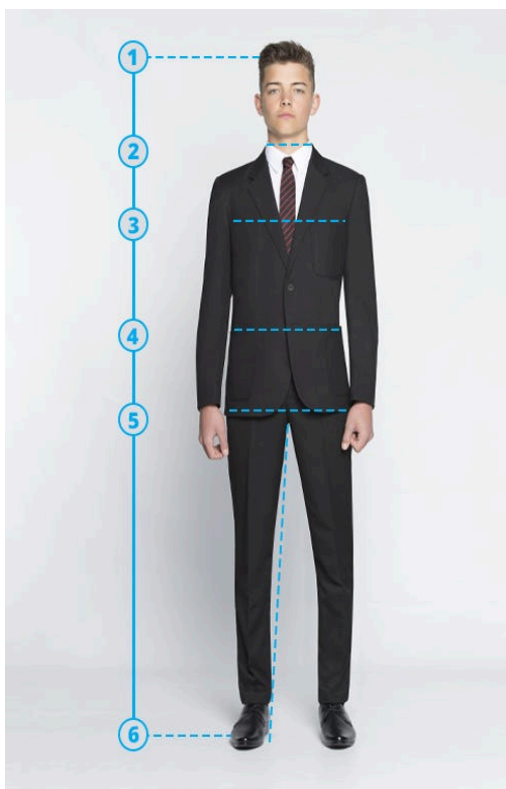
As new students you will receive a 50% discount on the blazer as it is the first provided. This will automatically be applied to payment on Parent Pay. Therefore the blazer cost for all year 7 parents will be £14.22.

As promised, we will swap any like-for-like SJCR branded uniform items, i.e. jumpers or PE kit for the same size Stepney All Saints uniform. If you have any items that require swapping please complete the following google form;

Size Guide and Exchanges

Please use the measuring guide below to identify the best fit of uniform for your child when placing the order. Should your uniform item arrive and be incorrect in size, we will offer an exchange within 14 days of you receiving your uniform items, provided the items are returned in a good condition with all labels attached.



Size Guide

1. **Height** – This is best done barefoot, with feet together flat on the ground and back against a wall; measure from the top of the head to the ground.
2. **Neck** – Place the tape measure where the shirt collar would normally sit around the base of the neck. Leaving a little extra room is very important so that the collar is comfortable, so make sure not to pull too tightly.
3. **Chest** – Take the tape measure through the underarms, around the fullest part of the chest.
4. **Waist** – Measure around the natural waistline, not pulling too tightly to ensure comfort.
5. **Hips** – Standing straight with the heels together, take the tape measure around the fullest part of the bottom.
6. **Inside leg** – This time shoes on; measure from the inside leg to where the trouser is normally worn on the shoe. If you're unsure, trousers should sit approximately 5cm from the ground.

We appreciate your patience in getting our new branding in place, and aim to have all students in the correct school uniform by the Spring Term 2021.
