Key information

- Students that are considering a career in medicine but may not be suitable for the traditional route into medicine should consider this course.
- **A Levels in sciences** are required.
- Most universities provide **contextual offers**, which means that they will lower entry requirements.
- Use **Unifrog** to explore the courses available.
- Popular courses have been included in this booklet.

- Your **personal statement** should demonstrate your capabilities as a potential **university student**. You must refer to **super-curricular activities related to your A Levels/EPQ/BTEC and Biomedical science**.

Super-curricular activities:

1. Academic reading (outside your course syllabus)
 2. Enrichment activities including subject specific clubs or programmes, online courses, workshops, subject specific internships, competitions, SASS Futures, SASS Champions
 3. Online courses, videos, lectures, debates, documentaries, podcasts
 4. Visits to museums, galleries, libraries, universities
 5. Any other relevant activity that has enhanced your knowledge
- You are encouraged to undertake work experience.
