- Top universities require **A Level Mathematics**.
- Most universities provide **contextual offers**, which means that they will lower entry requirements.
- Use **Unifrog** to explore the courses available.
- Popular courses have been included in this booklet.

- Top universities expect your personal statement to be **outstanding**.
- Your **personal statement** should demonstrate your capabilities as a potential **university student**. You must refer to **super-curricular activities related to your A Levels/EPQ/BTEC and Economics**.

Super-curricular activities:

1. Academic reading (outside your course syllabus)
 2. Enrichment activities including subject specific clubs or programmes, online courses, workshops, subject specific internships, competitions, SASS Futures, SASS Champions
 3. Online courses, videos, lectures, debates, documentaries, podcasts
 4. Visits to museums, galleries, libraries, universities
 5. Any other relevant activity that has enhanced your knowledge
- You are encouraged to undertake work experience.
