# Key information

- Top universities require applicants to complete the **LNAT** (National Admissions Test for Law).
- Universities consider students that are undertaking **A Levels or BTECs**.
- Most universities provide **contextual offers**, which means that they will lower entry requirements.
- Popular courses have been included in this booklet.

- Your **personal statement** should demonstrate your capabilities as a potential **university student**. You must refer to **super-curricular activities related to your A Levels/EPQ/BTEC and Law**.

## **Super-curricular activities:**

1. Academic reading (outside your course syllabus)
  2. Enrichment activities including subject specific clubs or programmes, online courses, workshops, subject specific internships, competitions, SASS Futures, SASS Champions
  3. Online courses, videos, lectures, debates, documentaries, podcasts
  4. Visits to museums, galleries, libraries, universities
  5. Any other relevant activity that has enhanced your knowledge
- You should be a member of the **Law Champions Pathway**. Refer to the activities undertaken in your personal statement.

**The National Admissions Test for Law is required for these universities:**

1. University of Bristol
2. Durham university
3. University of Glasgow
4. King's College London (KCL)
5. London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE)
6. University of Nottingham
7. University of Oxford
8. University college London (UCL)
9. SOAS

- Registration opens in **August** and tests can be taken from **September**.
- The fee is **£75** but you can apply for a bursary using this link <https://lnat.ac.uk/registration/paying-for-your-test/lnat-bursaries/>
- You must book this test independently
- You are strongly encouraged to do the test early so that you can spend Year 13 focussing on schoolwork.
