Key information

- **A Level Biology, Chemistry** and one additional subject.
- Averaging **AAA** in A Levels.
- Most universities provide **contextual offers**, which means that they will lower entry requirements.
- **UCAT** may be required depending on the university.
- **BMAT** may be required depending on the university.
- **Interviews** are required as part of the selection process.
- **Work experience** in a health and social care setting is preferred.
- Your personal statement should refer to both **work experience and super-curricular activities**, particularly academic reading.

- **Universities in London have higher entry requirements** (average AAA) whereas universities outside of London have lower requirements (average BBB).
- Be sensible with your choices and only continue pursuing this path if you are currently averaging AAA or higher and will be able to achieve these grades next year.
- Students that are unlikely to achieve top grades in their A Levels are encouraged to apply for the **extended medical degree or medicine with a foundation year**, as the requirements are lower, or study **biomedical sciences** and enter medicine through the graduate route.
- Use **Unifrog** to explore the courses available.
- Popular course choices have been included in this booklet.

UCAT

Registration opens on **22nd June 2022** and closes on the **22nd September 2022**.

- The 2022 UCAT must be completed between **11 July** and **29 September 2022**.
- The fee is **£70** but you can apply for a bursary using this link: <https://www.ucat.ac.uk/register/bursary-scheme/>
- You must book this test independently as you cannot complete this in school.
- You are strongly encouraged to complete this during the summer holidays.
