The timetable for the Year 9 examinations in December 2022 is on the reverse of this letter. The window for the Y9 examinations will be from Thursday 1st to Wednesday 7th December 2022. Please note down the relevant dates and times and ensure that you are properly prepared for each examination. These exams are organised and run the same way that public examinations are so strict examination rules apply. Under new exam regulations, watches of any kind are not permitted in the exam room.

For all examinations, the following procedures apply. All students are expected in lessons as normal so they will need all their equipment and books when there is not an exam scheduled.

Exams will be held across the following rooms; *The Great Hall, The Cube (S14), and P02*. The week before your assessments the Exam team will post up rooming and seating arrangements on the Exam noticeboard and also in your form rooms so please keep an eye out for this.

As per last academic year, students with Access Arrangements, will sit all exams in allocated rooms and will be provided with the necessary provisions by the SEN Department.
