I am writing again with regard to the upcoming induction events at Stepney All Saints. You may be aware that industrial action is planned to take place in schools on Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July. Student Induction Day (7.7.23)

If you are collecting your child from the Bromley Street gate, please wait opposite the gate on the green rather than immediately outside the gate as this causes congestion.
